The charm and strength of watercolor medium comes from its luminosity and fluidity. To learn how to paint in wet-in-wet is an ultimate challenge for those who want to master the medium. Painting in this fashion takes tremendous skill, artistic judgement and imagination, and courage, but it also provides the deepest satisfaction in the meantime.

In this four session of class, JJ will give demos at the beginning of each session to show how to use the techniques to transform a mundane picture into an atmospheric/poetic painting. Critiques will be offered if we have time at the end of the sessions.

JJ Jiang is a gifted and classically trained artist and a respected teacher; he possesses solid foundations in drawing, perspective and colors. Though accomplished in watercolor, he also excels in oils, Chinese brush painting/calligraphy and with a variety of subjects including landscape and cityscapes, human figures and portraits, as well as still life. His in-depth understanding of both Eastern and Western cultures gives his art a fresh and surprising look while adding depth and poetry to his teaching. JJ currently lives in Cary, North Carolina and is the founder and director of the Village Art Circle Studio and Gallery in the heart of downtown Cary.
