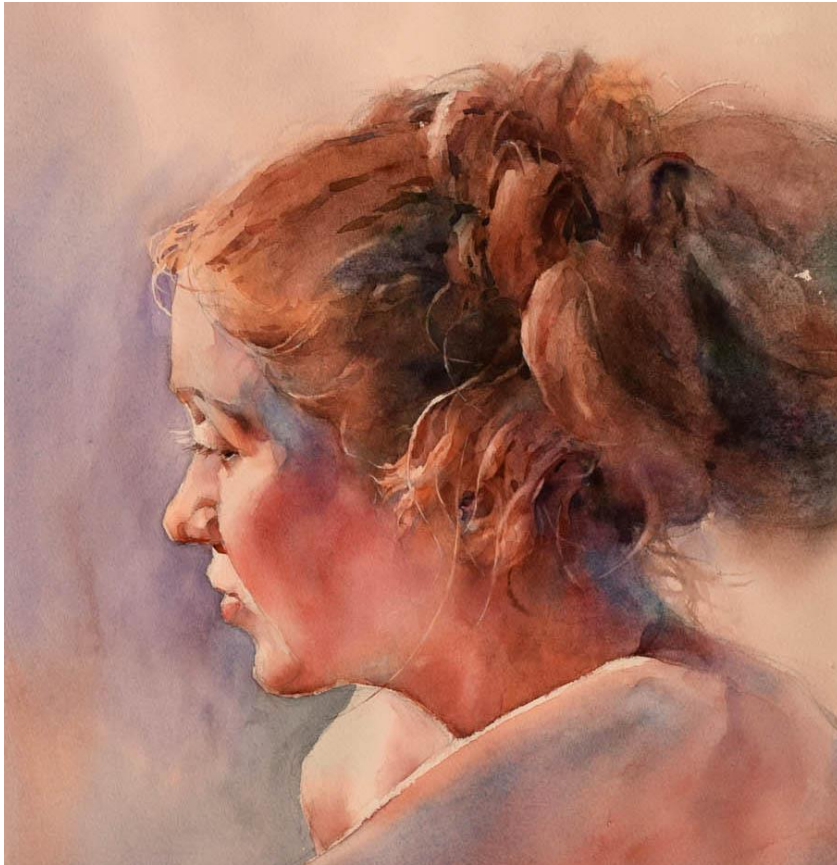


Two-Day Workshop: Watercolor Portraits

JJ Jiang is a gifted and classically trained artist and a respected teacher; he possesses solid foundations in drawing, perspective and colors. Though accomplished in watercolor, he also excels in oils, Chinese brush painting/calligraphy and with a variety of subjects including landscape and cityscapes, human figures and portraits, as well as still life. His in-depth understanding of both Eastern and Western cultures gives his art a fresh and surprising look while adding depth and poetry to his teaching.
